The Barranco Clinic has cleared fifteen (15) tons of trees, brush, and shrubs over the past year to make way for fresh landscaping, to include Indian Hawthorn shrubs, Yucca, Lilies, and Floratam sod. The property is a mixture of regional native and Florida-friendly plants which help to reduce the need for irrigation. A natural stone walkway is featured on the west side of the building.
