



SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING COMES TO WINTER HAVEN

Beginning July 12, 2011, the City of Winter Haven will offer a new Single-Stream Curbside Recycling pilot program. The Program will be for residents in the northern half of Winter Haven City limits. After completion of the six-month Pilot Program, Single-Stream Recycling will begin for all City residents.

What Does This Mean?

- Recycling will be easier and more efficient for all residents. You no longer have to spend time sorting recyclables, so more products can be recycled, with less effort.
- For easy curbside collection and to maximize participation, the City will provide a new 64-gallon recycling wheeled cart, allowing more recycling with each collection.
- Single-Stream materials are sorted at a special facility and then processed in individual streams. *Simply stated. . . we'll sort for you.*

How Will The Program Work?

- Recyclables should be prepared in the usual manner: cardboard and boxes broken down and containers rinsed. Plastic items and aluminum cans may be crushed to save space.
- Simply place all recyclables in your new recycling container and wheel it to the curb or edge of pavement on your collection day. . . **IT'S THAT EASY!!**

What's Next?

- The week of July 4, 2011, residents living in the northwest and northeast sections of the City of Winter Haven will receive a new recycling container. Curbside collection will start July 12, 2011.

WINTER HAVEN GARBAGE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION ROUTE CHANGES

Starting July 2011, Winter Haven will roll out new waste collection routes.

Changes begin July 11, 2011 to improve residential customer service, reduce the number of refuse trucks on the road and increase the efficiency of the waste disposal fleet.

New Collection Routes are as Follows:

- For residents who live in the City limits North of State Route 542 (this road is also known as Avenue G NW, North Lake Howard Drive, Central Avenue and Dundee Road), garbage and recycling will be collected each Tuesday; and Friday will be garbage pick-up only.
- For residents who live in the City limits South of State Route 542 (this road is also known as Avenue G NW, North Lake Howard Drive, Central Avenue and Dundee Road), Monday will be garbage pick-up only; and garbage and recycling will be collected each Thursday.
