

CITY OF WINTER HAVEN WASTE FACTS COMMERCIAL COLLECTION

WELCOME TO THE CITY OF WINTER HAVEN

As a new business to the community, the Solid Waste Division wishes to supply you with some information relating to your refuse service that may prove helpful.

Commercial refuse is collected six (6) days a week. The number of collections per week and the size of the container used will be determined by the amount of refuse generated by your business.

Businesses that share a common location may share a container, and the cost of the container shall be determined by the businesses using the container as long as the monthly charge per customer is equal to the minimum of \$18.76 per month.

Container Placement: Container placement must be on your property and upon a pad of concrete built to engineering specifications. Usually a container pad 10' X 10' for a container that is open (no enclosure), and 12' X 12' for an enclosed pad. If the enclosure has gates the refuse driver will either open or close them, however, not both.

Businesses using a residential container (hobo) will be collected twice weekly, same as residential routes and on the same days as residential. The container must be at curbside no later than 7:00 a.m. on collection day and in by no later than 10:00 a.m. the day after collection day.

No Loose Garbage: All residential type containers being used for commercial businesses must place loose materials in sealed/tied bags, or other such holders, to prevent loose litter. The same requirements are for commercial dumpsters as well.

Materials Allowed in Containers: No horticulture, junk, building or demolition debris, shall be placed in a commercial container or a residential type container used for commercial businesses. These materials will be collected upon request by the City's Trashmaster Operation or by roll-off containers where permitted. A special fee will be charged based on the rate structure set forth in this fact sheet.

Anything within the enclosure, other than the dumpster, which might possibly damage gate or walls will not be the responsibility of the City of Winter Haven.

_____ agrees to have the gates open on the day of scheduled pickup prior to the time the container would be emptied. If the gates are not open, _____ agrees to pay for the driver to return to empty the container since this entails an extra pickup unless agreed to be picked up on next scheduled day.

_____ agrees to hold the City of Winter Haven harmless of damage incurred to the refuse container pad in those situations where the contractor or owner has not met the specifications set down by the engineering department pertaining to construction of the pad.
