## LIBRARY MEMORIES

### ENTRY RULES:

- All entries must be completed using the provided template AND must be accompanied by a completed entry form. The official template and entry form are available at the Winter Haven Public Library and [www.mywinterhaven.com/library](http://www.mywinterhaven.com/library).
- The deadline to submit entries is close of business September 6 (midnight for electronic entries).
- All artwork must be original, previously unpublished, and free of copyright restrictions.
- The basic card dimension is 1.875 inches by 3.125 inches. Both horizontal and vertical designs will be considered.
- For computer-generated or digital photographic submissions, there is a minimum resolution of 300 dpi.
- Paper entries using colored pencil, pen, paint, camera, or computer-generated art are permitted. Artwork should be two-dimensional for printing purposes.
- Late entries will not be accepted.
- The selected design(s) will have the 'Polk County Library Cooperative, Florida' wording added, please keep this in mind as you create your design.
- Artwork that is found offensive or not appropriate for the contest will not be considered.
- If artwork does not meet the previous guidelines, it will not be considered, no exceptions.
- Submit in person at the library OR by email to [cgreear@mywinterhaven.com](mailto:cgreear@mywinterhaven.com) in JPEG, PSD, AI, EPS, or PNG format. (Depending on size of the document, digital submissions may be required to be brought in on a flash drive.)

### AFTER YOU SUBMIT:

- The winner(s) will be contacted and announced by September 12.
- The winning design(s) will be used as special limited edition library cards, and may also be used on library card promotional materials, including posters, bags, bookmarks, forms and flyers and on the library's website.
- All rights to the artwork will belong to the Winter Haven Public Library, 325 Avenue A NW, Winter Haven, Florida 33881.
- Winning artwork may need to be modified to comply with City of Winter Haven branding guidelines.
