SUBJECT: South Lake Howard Drive Pedestrian Improvements

BACKGROUND:

The City was awarded \$428,525 through an FDOT grant for construction of pedestrian improvements along South Lake Howard with design to be funded by the City. The project extends from Avenue D SW to 15th Street SW along South Lake Howard Drive (boundary map included in Task Order). The project is slated for construction in FY2021-FY2022. A scope has been outlined that balances available funding and adding pedestrian facilities within existing right of way. This is a heavily used corridor and improving the pedestrian access along this stretch would be of significant benefit to the community creating pedestrian facilities where none exist today. The project will also be completed in a fashion that future projects to the East and West can connect to it.

Kimley-Horn has prepared a Task Order on the Master Continuing Professional Services Agreement awarded March 2020 under RFQ-20-01, to evaluate the corridor, complete survey work (including right of way confirmation), provide two alternative pathway configurations (including renderings and an opinion of probable cost), development of construction plans with reviews at 60%, 90%, and 100% with opinion of probable cost at each, as well as support on coordination with FDOT, the community, and the bidding process.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Kimley Horn's proposed Task Order accomplishes all of these elements for \$49,950. This is to be paid from Transportation Impact Fees.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Manager to approve the Task Order with Kimley-Horn for Pedestrian Enhancements along South Lake Howard and take all other actions necessary and thereto.


